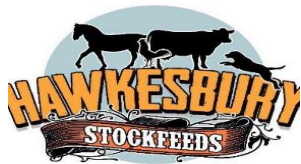

Eligibility for this ring is at the discretion of the competitor's Pony Club Chief Instructor. Riders cannot compete in any other ring on the day. Riders who have competed in **Zone Pony Club Championship** competition (in any discipline) **ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THIS RING**. A Zone Jamboree is not regarded as a Championship competition.

Events will be judged at walk, trot and minimal canter. Canter will only be asked to be demonstrated during individual workouts.
