- **ENTRY FEE:** \$5.00 Payment can be made by cheque (to Hawkesbury District Agricultural Association), Credit Card, or cash ONLY. CASH not accepted through mail.
- **ENTRIES CLOSE:** by POST - Hawkesbury Show Office PO Box 382 Richmond 2753 or at Showground - Gate 2, 40 Racecourse Road, Clarendon on MONDAY 29th April 2019 BY 4.00pm
- **ENTRIES ONLINE:** MONDAY 29th April 2019 BY 4.00pm

- **ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS:** Entry Forms and Waivers can be downloaded from www.hawkesburyshowground.com.au. Each exhibitor and any other person that handles the animal must sign a waiver on the day of entry and get a wristband.
- **DELIVERY OF EXHIBITS:** All Donkeys must be delivered to the Showground by 8:30am on the day of Judging (12th May 2019). Please enter the Showground via **Gate 3**, 40 Racecourse Road, Clarendon.
- Vehicles must be removed from the Showgrounds and parked in the appropriate Exhibitor Carpark BEFORE 9am.
- Please ensure you and anyone handling your donkey have signed a Waiver and received a wristband.
- **All exhibitors must pay the gate entry fee unless Members. Special Livestock Exhibitor fee is \$10.00 per exhibitor and handlers.**
- **JUDGING:** Sunday 12th May 2019
- Note: all events will also be judged on appearance and presentation of the rider/handler.
- **PRIZES:** 1st \$5.00, 2nd 3rd Ribbon. Champions as listed *All fees & prizes include GST.* Prize vouchers should be collected from the Steward and presented for payment either during the Show at the cash office or after the show at the Secretary's office by **FRIDAY 14th JUNE 2019**

ANIMAL WELFARE POLICY

Hawkesbury District Agricultural Association (HDAA) provides for the welfare and how we treat animals on the showground. The expectations and requirements are for the care of animals and if exhibitors breach these conditions HDAA may take action if required through ejecting the involved exhibitor and/or reporting the incident to the RSPCA for legal action.

Animal Welfare is a human responsibility that encompasses all aspects of animal well being. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Proper housing
- Management
- Nutrition
- Responsible care
- Humane handling, and
- Veterinary treatment

REGULATIONS

1. All donkeys/mules must be disease and vermin free.
2. All exhibitors and competitors including juniors must complete entry the waiver and wear a wristband. This also includes anybody who is handling the donkeys.
3. The judge and/or stewards reserve the right to refuse any exhibit to the ring.
4. The judge's decision is final.
5. Marshall and steward's directions must be followed.
6. Exhibitors must acknowledge the judge with a nod (address only the steward if necessary) and shake hands when the ribbon is awarded. Competitors congratulate place-getters.
7. Riders and drivers must wear a hard hat.
8. Drivers must be 16 years and over, otherwise accompanied by experienced adult driver.
9. Obstacle class is judged on ability and open to all ages.
10. Standing jump is elimination round according to height jumped and refusals or bar knockdowns.
11. Dress code applies. Boots, jacket/vest, hat recommended.
12. **Novice section** is open to exhibitors in their first show as a handler and donkeys that have not previously won a ribbon.
13. Any donkey/mule deemed unfit or unsound will be ineligible for entry into the ring.
