- 1. Unless otherwise stated the competition is open to all photographers.
- 2. Due to limited exhibition space a maximum of **one entry** may be submitted in any one class
- 3. The back of each print must show the exhibitor's name, address, phone number, title of

photograph, class entered and a mark to indicate the top when viewed correctly.

4. Entries in Junior Classes 18009, 18010, 18021 & 18022 **MUST state age of the entrant and title of the photo** on the entry form. Age is taken from the 1st day of the show.

ENTRIES WITHOUT THIS INFORMATION WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

5. Prints may be either commercially or author processed.

6. All entries must be accompanied by a completed entry form and entry fees.

7. Permission to reproduce entries for publication to promote the Hawkesbury Show will be assumed unless otherwise specified. Winning entries may be displayed by the sponsor for a short time.

8. The best possible care will be taken, but no responsibility will be accepted for damage or loss of entries.

9. The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry which, in its opinion, may not be suitable for public display.

10. The Committee reserves the right to split and/or combine classes where circumstances require. 11. The Portrait, Nature/Landscape and Botanical/Agricultural & other classes are open to any

monochrome, colour or mini print. They will be judged for the best photo irrespective of format 12. Photographs in all classes must be NEW entries in that class. Entries will be accepted for

photographs which have been entered in ONE previous Hawkesbury Show PROVIDED they are entered in a DIFFERENT class to the previous entry, whether winning or not. An exception to this rule is a photograph which has been re-printed, copied or cropped, which may be treated as a NEW photograph.

13. All entries must be the work and property of the exhibitor and cannot be copies of work by other people.

14. Prints must be mounted on stiff **MATT BOARD** or foam core with a 2cm border with a proper backing to securely hold the photo (check with your photographic supplier), and NOT FRAMED by **glass or on canvas or timber**. Presentation of your exhibit is very important. Photos MUST be on photo paper ONLY, (**NO PHOTOS UNDER GLASS**) and conform to the following sizes: *OPEN MONOCHROME* and COLOUR PRINTS (classes 18001 & 18002)

Maximum size ALL ENTRIES 30cm x 35cm (12" x 14") including mount. If in doubt please phone Chief Steward.

MINI PRINTS (class 18003) Minimum 10 x 10cm (4 x 4") including mount Maximum 20 x 25cm (8 x 10") including mount

ALL OTHER PRINTS (classes 18001-18002 & 18004 -18014)
Minimum 15 x 10cm (6 x 4") NOT including mount
Maximum 30 x 35cm (12 x 14") including mount
If in doubt contact the Chief Steward.
Please use e.g. Post Office padded bags to deliver your photos.
No oversize bags please.
NOTE: Panorama and other shaped prints are acceptable in the above classes PROVIDING
they conform to the overall dimensions, i.e. a panorama print measuring 10 x 60cm would be
acceptable. A print measuring 20 x 150cm would be oversized.
Oversized prints, or prints not mounted correctly, will NOT be judged and may not be displayed.
