	The form must be completed by all competitors/exhibitors and handed in at the Horse Office immediately on arrival at the Showground and a wrist band collected as evidence of completion. Alternatively, the form can be downloaded from website, <a href="http://www.hawkesburyshowground.com.au/show/schedules">http://www.hawkesburyshowground.com.au/show/schedules</a> , complete and sign and brought to the Horse Office on arrival and collect a wrist band.  A Risk Waiver must be completed by all additional riders, handlers and passengers
	(eg. harness, heavy horse classes), same arrangements as above.
Unable to Compete	Refunds will be considered after the Show, on receipt by the Show Secretary of a <b>DETAILED WRITTEN REQUEST</b> stating the amount to be refunded, classes entered, accompanied by Veterinarian Certificate (Horse) or Doctor's Certificate (Rider). <b>An administration fee of \$20 will apply to all competitors applying for a refund</b> .
Extreme Weather	Should the Bureau of Meteorology predict severe weather for the day of the Show, the Committee will consider not proceeding with the scheduled date. If the Show is postponed entries will be transferred to the new date and if the new date is not convenient to a competitor, a refund can be arranged by deleting the entry on Global prior to the revised Entry Closure date. Refunds will be given after costs incurred have been deducted. If the Show has commenced and abandoned there will be no refunds

- Ring 4 Leading Rein, Junior Riders Welsh, Part Bred Welsh, Australian Saddle Ponies, Australian Ponies and Riding Ponies Stud Book, Adult Riders
- Ring 5 Light Harness, Miniature Horses, Miniature Ponies, Shetlands
- Ring 6 Purebred Arabians, Arabian Derivatives, Western Breed, Coloured Ponies and Horses, Any Other Colour/ Breed (Not listed in Schedule),
- Ring 7 Australian Stock Horses and ASH Riders

#### **RULES:**

- 1 Ridden Hack, Galloway, Pony, Show Hunter and Riding classes shall be conducted according to AgShowNSW rules. In addition, please note the following rules:
  - (a) A person must not enter at a show any horse to which a Prohibited Substance has been administered or permit a horse to which a Prohibited Substance has been administered to compete.
  - (b) The Competitor, the Owner and an Attendant of any horse in which a Prohibited Substance is detected is deemed to be in breach of these rules.
  - Subject to (b) above, a horse to which a Prohibited Substance has been administered may not compete and is not eligible to compete.
  - Breed classes shall be conducted according to the rules of the relevant breed society/association
- 2 All competing riders MUST wear an approved safety helmet with the retaining harness secured.
- Any exhibitor wanting to protest against a judge's decision must lodge the protest in writing within ONE HOUR of the decision. The protest must be lodged with the HDAA's Administration and Business Manager, together with a fee of \$50 which will be refunded if the protest is upheld.
- 4 Stallions must wear a bit and at all times be under the control of a competent handler aged 17 years or over. Stallions are NOT permitted in classes unless specified.
- 5 Only competitors, attendants and officials will be allowed in the arena.
- No competitor or other person is permitted to enter a ring area and query a judge. All enquiries must be directed to the Chief Horse Steward at the Horse Office.

  No competitor will present for judging before a judge with whom he/she has a family relationship,

has, or has recently had a personal relationship or has had horse related business dealings during the past twelve months.

- 7 Coaching: Any person detected coaching a competitor while that competitor is being judged may be removed from the Showground.
- Proper Conduct: Any exhibitor or associate who behaves offensively on the Showground will be expelled from the ground, may be banned from the show in future and may be banned by other Societies.
- Outside assistance to competitors by word, radio or any other method in Horse Ring Events will NOT be permitted. If in breach of this ruling, competitors and their exhibits may be dismissed from the event and from the Showground. Competitors' names will be submitted to the ASC.
- 10 All exhibitors must be able to produce an official measurement certificate if required.
- 11 Proof of current registration with the recognised relevant Breed Society or Association must be available on request.
- 12 ALL competitors, including handlers, strappers, carriage passengers, must complete a 'Risk Warning' form as part of the entry process and display the allocated wrist band on competition day when inside the Showground.
- 13 Dogs are **NOT ALLOWED** on the Showgrounds any time during the Show.
- 14 Stewards have the authority to control horse activities in the Show ring. **Failure to comply with directions issued by the Stewards** may result in forfeiture of entry to subsequent classes on the day and/or refusal of entries the following year.
- 15 For the safety of competitors and spectators the following also applies:
  - Non-motorised wheeled trolleys, prams etc containing a permitted support animal or child must remain <u>outside</u> the main arena fence at all times and must NOT be taken into the main showground arena.
  - Non-motorised wheeled trolleys, not containing a child or permitted support animal, may be taken onto the main showground arena at the owner's risk; but must remain against the main arena fence at all times.
  - If competitors require mobility/disability/motorised assistance to the ring or in the ring, they must contact the organising committee via email, BEFORE close of entries so that this may be included in the event organiser's risk assessment. This ensures correct safety procedures are followed as per the event organiser's risk assessment policy.
  - All participants using motorised/mobility assistance are required to wear an EA approved safety helmet, or medically approved head protective wear (please provide a doctor's/specialist's letter in support of any medically approved head protective wear).
- 16 **Class Clashes**: Please note that due to the operation of multiple rings there is likely to be clashes between some classes. In the scheduling of classes every endeavour has been made to minimise these where possible. However, due to horses having multiple registrations and as up to 6 rings may be in operation at any one time, class clashes may occur. If this occurs the competitor may have to make a choice as to which class they will compete in. Your understanding and cooperation will be appreciated.
- 17 The Committee reserves the right to alter Judges.
- 18 After a fall from their mount a rider is disqualified from that class and must not remount their mount in the ring.
- 19 Refund Requests of entry fee after entry closing date will be considered after the Show, on receipt by the Show Secretary of a **DETAILED WRITTEN REQUEST** stating the amount to be refunded, classes entered, accompanied by Veterinarian Certificate or Doctor's Certificate. **An administration fee will apply to all competitors applying for a refund**.
- 20 Class entries on the day will be accepted at cost of \$15 per class, tickets must be purchased, details completed and submitted to the Horse Office by 9 AM on the morning of the Show.

  DEFINITIONS:
- Newcomer Eligibility restricted to a horse that has not competed UNDER SADDLE (excluding racing), prior to 1<sup>st</sup> January 2025. Once competed under saddle, such horse ceases to be a Newcomer on the 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025.
- 2 Novice one that has never won a first prize at a show in a similar class.
- 3 <u>Intermediate</u> is one that has not won a first, second or third prize at a Royal Show in a similar class
- 4 <u>Age</u> where this is a condition of a class, the age of the person is on the day of the event and the age of the horse is the preceding 1st August.
- Amateur Owner / Rider the horse must be owned and exhibited by the Rider who is an Amateur (a person who in the last 2 years has not received any 'payment' for coaching, training, riding or showing any horse for another person) and or a member of the Rider's immediate family, for a

period of not less than 3 months. The horse must not have been shown, or ridden or trained by a Non – Amateur, within the previous 3 months.

#### 6. Thoroughbred Sport Horse Association

Class Eligibility Requirements: your horse can be either a hack or show hunter, your horse must be registered with the Australian Thoroughbred Stud Book, have a microchip number and a <u>TSHA</u> <u>competition licence</u>. The microchip number is important, it does not matter whether the horse is EA registered with a different name so long as the description and microchip number match. TSHA competition licences can be purchased on Global Entries by logging in and going to the 'Manage Horses' page. For more information visit <u>www.thoroughbredsporthorse.com.au</u>

7. <u>Standardbred ridden classes</u> – the following definitions applies:

Newcomers ridden Standardbred – refer Definition 1 above.

Intermediate ridden Standardbred - refer Definition 3 above

Walk, Trot Ridden Standardbred - no eligibility requirement - judged on walk, trot only.

**Open ridden Standardbred** is open to any standardbred horse irrespective of past showring performance and is expected to walk, trot, canter and may be asked for simple changes of leg and lengthening.

8. Thoroughbred Off the Track Classes - These are open to all Thoroughbreds that have officially raced or trialled, either locally, nationally or internationally. All horses must be 3 years old and over and over 14.2hh. Horses must have a Life Number or be registered with a recognised studbook. Racing name to be used when entering OTT horses
