**LED CLASSES:**

(Delivery of Cattle – must be delivered to the Showground by 7:00am Sunday, 8 May 2022. A feeding curfew should be enforced from 9pm Saturday, 7 May 2022).

- H1 - Light Weight 280 – 405 Kg live weight
- H2 - Middle Weight 406 – 480 Kg live weight
- H3 - Heavy Weight 481 – 550 Kg live weight

**NON-LED CLASSES:**

(Delivery of Cattle - must be delivered to the Showground Cattle Yards between 6:00pm-9:00pm on Saturday, 7 May 2022, a feeding curfew will be enforced at 9pm Saturday, 7 May 2022).

- H4 - Cattle will be judged in three weight divisions with prizes for each.
  - Light Weight 280 – 405 Kg live weight
  - Middle Weight 406 – 480 Kg live weight
  - Heavy Weight 481 – 550 Kg live weight

**SUMMARY OF COMPETITIONS:**

\*ENTRIES CLOSE: At the Show Office on 4pm, 28<sup>th</sup> April 2022

\*Weighing of all steers and heifers - to commence at the Showground from 7:30am Sunday, 8<sup>th</sup> May 2022  
At the cattle yard crush.

\*Judging will take place on Sunday, 8<sup>th</sup> May 2022 at the Hawkesbury Showground, Cattle Lawn & Cattle Yards, starting with unled cattle approx. 9:30 am, then followed by led classes.

Only first prize winners in each Led & Un-Led class are eligible to compete for the Champion and Reserve. Led and Unled Champions will then compete for the Grand Champion/Reserve Grand Champion Prime Beef winner.

**ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES:** The attention of intending Exhibitors is drawn to the fact that entries are accepted subject to the General Competition Rules and Regulations of this Association, in addition to the Regulations & Conditions which appear below.

**The following is to be provided with each entry:**

1. Health certificate for property where animals are located.
2. Pestivirus test certificate for each animal entered. (Led cattle only)

All persons in the Cattle area, exhibitors or passive helpers will need to fill out the "Risk Warning" Indemnity / Waiver document. This form can be completed and submitted on the day. A wrist band will be provided and must be worn when involved in any cattle activities.

**REGULATIONS & CONDITIONS:**

- \* Steers & heifers may be of any breed or cross breed and within the competition weights.
- \* All entrants must be led by a halter and nose rings or nose grips.
- \* All entrants must always be in the care of the exhibitor or representative.
- \* All entrants will be assigned to a class dependent on their weight recorded by the steward when weighed on the morning of the competition. If doubt should arise in the mind of the Judge, in any Class, as to the classification of a competing animal, the matter will be referred to the Stewards for consideration.
- \* Every care will be taken of exhibits, but the Association will not be responsible for any losses, deaths, or accidents to stock.
- \* Bedding will NOT be provided. Exhibitors are required to provide their own bedding.

- \* It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to ensure that the leaders of their cattle in judging rings and parades are capable of exercising control over the animals in their care.
- \* All stalled cattle must be secured with neck collars and halters.
- \* All animals must have NLIS identification.
- \* A copy of your NVD/TSS must be handed to the Chief Steward.
- \* Stewards have the right to remove any animal from the Judging Ring if that animal is a danger to the safety of the public.
- \* No drug, hormone or tranquillizer shall be administered to any animal exhibit except under the direction of the Association's Veterinary Surgeon whom will advise the Stewards.
- \* All cattle must comply with health requirements as stipulated by Biosecurity
- \* Any animal, which in the opinion of the Stewards is not in a fit state to be exhibited, may be rejected by them and debarred from competing in the class or classes for which it is entered. Any animal rejected must be removed from the Showgrounds as soon as the exhibitor is notified.
