Class 16663 Article primarily made from paper and/or cardboard (max. size 60cmW x 40cmD x 50cmH)

Class 16664 Article primarily made from garden/farm/household, tools, utensils or equipment (max. size 60cmW x 40cmD x 50cmH)

Class 16665 Article made primarily from used or waste wire or metal. (max. size 60cmW x 40cmD x 50cmH)
